UN PROGRAMS

UN Update - Kathy Holmes

Zonta International partners with various UN agencies to make a difference in the lives of women and girls through service and advocacy actions that focus on education and the prevention of violence against women and girls.

As the volunteer UN member for Zonta Redcliffe, I will provide an update on the projects Zonta International is partnering in with the UN. This month's instalment is:

[Ending Child Marriage](#) - A program to accelerate Global Action. Zonta International is partnering with the UN Population Fund (UNFPA) and UN International Children's Emergency Fund (UNICEF) for this program. This program is currently in phase II.

In 2020 Zonta International has committed an additional US\$1,500,000 to UNICEF USA to support Phase II of the Global program through 2022. The overall goals of Phase II include:

1. Elevating the voice and agency of adolescent girls
2. Increasing resources and opportunities for adolescent girls and their families
3. Enhancing legal and political action to prevent child marriage and to support married, divorced or widowed adolescent girls

Breaking news - Natasha Stott-Despoja has been elected onto the United Nations Committee on the Discrimination against Women.
